



Texas Bear Round-Up 17 Vendor Market Information

The Dallas Bears are excited that you are interested in being a vendor for TBRU 17. **Space is limited – so, reserve your vendor booth as soon as possible.** Our Vendor Market is located on the second floor of the host hotel in the Warwick, Newbury, Churchhill Rooms and the hallways connecting these rooms to the elevators of our host hotel. We also have a few spots that could be available in the Mezzanine area for smaller or limited product vendors. Vendor Market Terms and Conditions

Vendor Space – Each Vendor will be provided a vendor space which includes a single 8’ table (\$100.00)

- **Due to limited space this year no additional tables or more than one space permitted per vendor.**
 - **Adult item vendors will be placed in the designated adult item area, all others will be placed in the hallways and meeting rooms on the 2nd floor (see chart)**
 - Each vendor is responsible for their product, monies and vendor space.
 - Each vendor should have at least one person (**must be at least 21 years old**) representing the vendor in their vendor space throughout vendor market operating hours. TBRU vendor market staff and volunteers will not be responsible for your area when unattended by you or your helper.
 - TBRU staff reserves the right to approve or deny any application/registration for the Vendor Market. We strive to offer a wide variety of goods and products at TBRU.
- **Vendor space will be assigned this year and consideration will be placed on vendor items previous mentioned**
 - **Vendor space will be forfeited if vendor does not show within 3 hrs of the start of TBRU. Exceptions will be considered if vendor contacts the TBRU Vendor Market Director before the start of TBRU to report an exceptional situation for late arrival**

Adult Items – Since the vendor market is open to the public, there are a couple of things to watch for. Texas has a few laws that we can not get away from. This is for those that are going to be selling adult “toys”, movies, or pictures of anything nude or sexual in nature. In Texas, we cannot have in public view (where people can see it from the doorway) any of those items. We will have posted on the door the **“If you are offended by sexually explicit....”** statement. So, if you are planning on showing adult themed videos, you will have to have the screen pointed away from a door way. Just a reminder, we can never show public pictures of sexual intercourse occurring. **Therefore vendors who fall into this category cannot choose or be placed in vendor space that is in direct view of the public.**

Street Legal Attire - Also, if you are having any models at your booth they will have to comply with the law as well. They can go shirtless or even in a pair of underwear. However, we must keep it street legal. If they are wearing underwear, they will need to have their genitals and butt covered at all times. A jock strap that does not cover the anus/butt crack (must be one inch wide) is not considered street legal. That all falls into the Texas Public Lewdness Law.

Access to Vendor Market

- **On the first day of the vendor market vendors will have access to the market area 4 hours prior to opening for set-up time**
- Once the market opens vendors will have access to the vendor market as early as 30 minutes prior to opening to 20 minutes after public closing. This will allow for daily set up and tear down. Again, a representative must be present at all times during the public operating hours.
- When the Vendor Market Closes each day Vendors have two options:
 1. Leave product on tables with a table cover. **TBRU and the Hotel will provide drapes/covers for your tables. TBRU and the Hotel will provide professional security guards during “closed” hours to deter any criminal activity. Vendors should ever leave money, credit card information or checks at their vendor space when unattended.**
 2. Take product with you

NOTE: Where logistically possible – some vendor space tables could be moved into the vendor rooms if space allows.

- Once the Vendor Market area is closed there will be **no access** to the area. If you need to complete production work after closing you must do so in another area. To ensure effective security no one will be allowed in the vendor market area after hours.
- On closing day of the TBRU and the Vendors Market vendors must clear their area within 1.5 hours of the closing time in order for the hotel to prepare for the next incoming group.

Security – Vendors are solely responsible for their products and equipment. TBRU staff will work to ensure the best possible secure environment.

1. **TBRU will provide drapes/covers for your tables.**
2. **TBRU will limit access to the vendor market area afterhours.**
3. **TBRU will provide professional security guards during “closed” hours to deter any criminal activity.**
4. **Vendors agree to never leave money, credit card information or checks unattended in the vendor market. Likewise, vendors agree to remove any irreplaceable or extremely valuable items from the vendor market area when the space is unattended.**

Be Our Guest – As a vendor we invite you to attend our events. We know you are here for your business, but we hope you can take some free time to have some fun.

- Each vendor will be provided **two (2) Vendor ID Badges**
- One for you and one for a helper (**at least 21 years old**) working the vendor space(s) with you full-time
- \$50 fee for additional badges for additional helpers
- \$25 fee for lost or misplaced badges

Your Vendor ID Badge will allow you to access our events like the Hospitality Suite, Dinner, Texas BBQ, etc. This means that you are able to go to as many of the events as you would like. We would like to see each of you at the dinner on Saturday night. Since the badges require names, please forward to us the names of your staff that will be working. We will need the names for your badges by **March 5, 2012**.

Cancellations

- After **February 28, 2012** no refunds on cancellations will be given.

If you have any special needs, please let us know in advance.

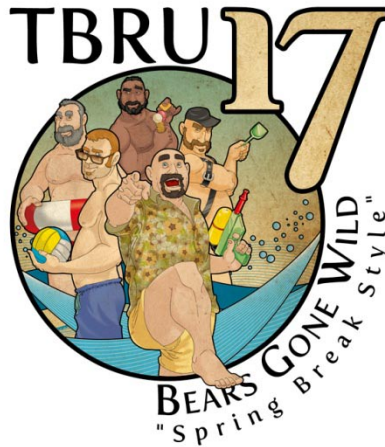
Hotel Bedrooms

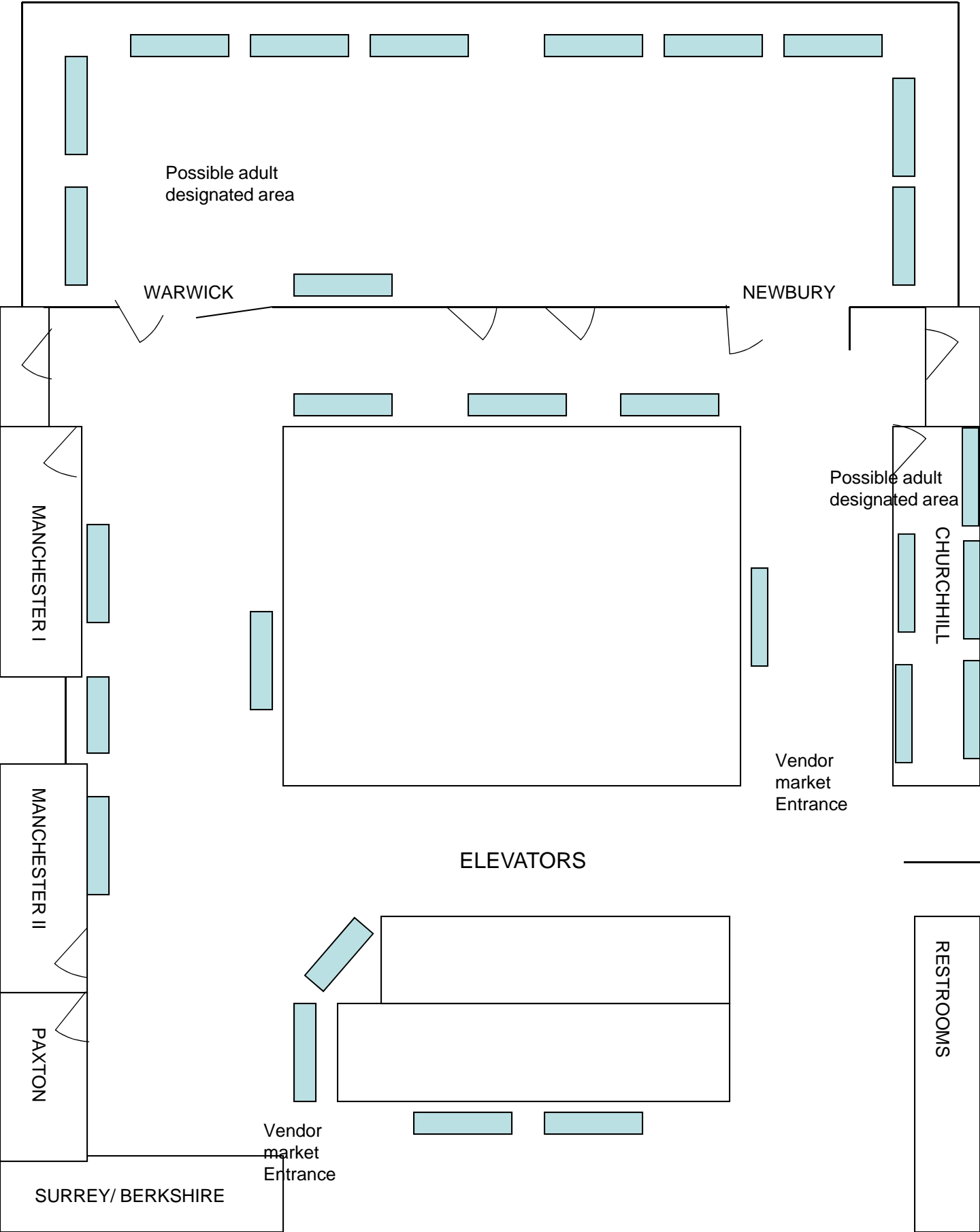

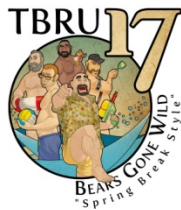
